- Interoperability is not a given for every PDF file, or for every purpose to which a PDF might be put
- ISO standards for PDF technology demonstrate a demand for more and better interoperability

- Missing or poor support for a given features makes a PDF unreliable (can happen even when creating files with the same vendor's software)
- An application allows users to add comments, but (a) does not use PDF's annotations model, and (b) renders the comment as masking page content!
 - An application ignores certain features in a PDF when reading it, which is OK... but then, without a warning, erases those features if the user changes and then saves the file!

 - Page-level editing
 - Page-view support
 - Signing and encryption

- Annotations
- Metadata
- Semantic structure
- Forms
- 3D annotations
- Rich media
- Embedded files
- Associated files
- ...and many more
