In 1993, PDF was born



- PDF: compatible connection point
 - between fragmented systems
 - Transport format
 - Exchange hub
 - Middleware (like ZUGFeRD)
- "Offline and visible evidence"
 - For tax and other records
 - Human readable renditions of data
 - In an otherwise "machine world"
 - The constant in a volatile business
 - Monthly statements for my ton of transactions

- A lightweight content management platform
- A PDF rendering PLUS
 - Machine-readable data
 - On-board metadata
 - Arbitrary attached files
 - Rich interactive features
 - Navigation and accessibility features
 - Powerful encryption and authentication
 - Rich re-use capabilities

More subtle (but no less critical!) features

- Content may be reliably deleted
- Readily interoperable with "external" content and workflows
- Technology-neutral; just the rendering and the framework
- Vendor-neutral; all aspects of the end-user's experience are technically transparent
