

Quick Stats

- Study in 2016 showed that 92 percent of managers and knowledge workers consider themselves paper document-dependent.
- Same study stated that 90 percent of those managers and workers said they are dependent on PDF technology to create and distribute documents.
- With over 2.5 trillion PDFs created every year, it's safe to say PDF is the most widely used document file type in the world.

Why Are PDFs Used Today?

- To be able to read, review, communicate, and manipulate information and data in a digital medium (Digital Paper);
- To ensure the document you send looks the same when your intended recipient opens it (Fidelity);
- To ensure only the intended person opens and views it (Security);
- To ensure the document is in a file format that can be opened on any device (Ubiquitous);
- To ensure documents are saved in a manner that will be accessible for many years in the future (Archive);


Criticisms of PDF

- PDF is not dynamic and therefore not as suitable for screens as HTML is.
- PDF is not as user friendly and/or accessible as HTML.
- You cannot collaborate on PDFs.
- Webpackages will replace the need for PDF.

- Adoption.







Wider Adoption of the PDF/A spec and improvement in the tools available.

Smarter collaboration in a digital medium




Increasingly necessary that data can be easily extracted from digital documents.




