Teleconference access is available to PDF Association working group members and ISO delegates participating via their country's member body organization. Members wishing to attend remotely will be notified of meeting-times and will receive calendar invitations through the usual means.

PDF Week is closely integrated with meetings of ISO TC 171 SC 2, the organization managing ISO standards for PDF technology. Unless they specifically register as not attending any ISO meeting during PDF week, all participants are required by ISO to:

- be listed in the ISO Global Directory, and
- register on ISO's website for the specific meetings you may attend.

If you are not already listed in the ISO Global Directory the PDF Association will add you based on your registration for PDF Week. Once listed, ISO will send you your ISO username and password. Once you have an ISO login you are ready to finalize your registration for PDF Week:

- Go to https://sd.iso.org/meetings and login with your ISO credentials, and
- Select each working group in ISO TC 171 SC 2 that you wish to attend.

For all PDF Week attendees we recommend registering for all ISO TC 171 SC 2 meetings occuring during PDF Week; there's no cost or obligation and it eases logistics during the conference.
